

Announcing The Lookout 's 2003 Senior Adult Writing Contest

A GAIN THIS YEAR The Lookout is sponsoring a writing contest for senior adults age 70 and over. The three winning articles will appear in our July 27, 2003 issue, along with the names of other writers who earn honorable mention. If you are 70 or older, we invite you to participate. Please follow these rules closely.

Contest Rules

1. To be eligible, writers must be no younger than 70 years old.
 - a. Employees of Standard Publishing Company and Berean Christian Stores, and their relatives, are ineligible.
 - b. Past contest winners are ineligible.
2. Only one article may be submitted by any author.
3. The article must be *nonfiction prose*

- (no poetry) dealing with some aspect of the theme, "The Church Then and Now:"
4. The article should contain 500-800 words, neatly typed, double-spaced, on one side of plain white 8 1/2 x 11" paper.
 5. Along with the article, the author should send: a self-addressed stamped #10 business envelope (SASE); a recent color photo; current address, phone number, and Social Security number (necessary for us to issue checks to the winners).
 6. **Your manuscript will not be returned.** Please keep a copy for your records.
 7. A panel of experienced authors and editors will examine all entries and make final decisions.
 8. **Deadline:** Entries must be postmarked by April 15, 2003 to be eligible.
